Explaining why he has chosen transparent watercolour as his favorite medium, he says, "What compels me to paint with this approach is the possibility of painting

quickly. It suits my personality best -- the fluidity of the medium provides a unique sensation of unexpected colour mixing, particularly when I define only the main masses and allow the unpredictable to happen on the rest of the paper."

This is Fabio's first live demonstration to an art group in Australia. He has a strong online following. Some members will enjoy 2 days with him as a tutor sharing his skills.
